

# ANGELS CHILD CARE FOOD PROGRAM

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The reimbursement rates are effective on July 1, 2023 and remain in effect through June 30, 2024. Reimbursement Rates Structure is as follows:

School attendance area information is essential for Angels Child Care Food Program and other sponsoring organizations to use in making proper determinations for family day care home reimbursement rates. Family day care homes located within the attendance area of an elementary school in which 50% or more of enrolled children have been determined eligible for free and reduce price school meals receive a higher, Tier I, reimbursement rate under the Child Care Food Program (CCFP). Tier II rates apply to family day care homes located in areas that do not meet the 50% free and reduced price meal criteria.

Tier II homes (homes that are **not** located within the attendance area of an elementary school that meets the above mentioned criteria) may accept these rates or choose from two options that may qualify a day care provider to receive the Tier I rates of reimbursement.

## THESE OPTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Complete a Provider Eligibility Application and include a copy of your most recent IRS 1040 income tax form and a Schedule C to verify your household income. If your family income meets the required criteria, or if you are receiving Food Stamps, FDPIR, CalWORKS, or Federally Funded Head Start, you will be eligible Tier I rates for all enrolled children, a well as your own children **under the age of 12 years.**
2. Request that Parent Eligibility Applications be sent to you and ask **all** your enrolled children's parents to complete them. It is alright if the parent declines, but providers **must** give all parents the option of filling out the application. All completed applications must be returned to our office **by the parent**, for reasons of confidentiality. If eligible, the provider becomes a Tier II-mixed home. Receiving Tier I rates for those children whose parents are income eligible and Tier II rates for all other enrolled children.

### TIER II

MEALS	CAPACITY SERVED	MEAL DAYS*	MONTHLY REIMBURSEMENT**
2 MAIN MEALS + 1 SNACK	6	22	\$529.32
2 MAIN MEALS + 1 SNACK	8	22	\$705.76
2 MAIN MEALS + 1 SNACK	12	22	\$1058.64
2 MAIN MEALS + 1 SNACK	14	22	\$1235.08

\*Based on a full month of 31 days, Monday – Friday which equals 22 meal days. Examples in Lunch, PM Snack and Supper, claiming Breakfast, Snack and Lunch will be slightly lower. \*\*Approximate
